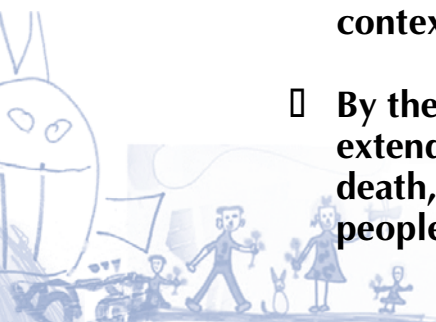
Selskabet indbyder hermed til kursus med **Glenda Fredman**

**"Death Talk"**  
***At arbejde med børn og familier omkring døden.***

**Glenda Fredman** is a clinical psychologist and systemic family psychotherapist. She has worked extensively with dying children and older people and with bereaved families in hospitals and community settings in London, England. She provides consultation and training to staff working with the bereaved and the dying throughout the UK and Europe.

Glenda takes a systemic, social constructionist and narrative approach to working with people in illness and dying. In this workshop she will present some of the practices and ideas from her book *Death Talk: Conversations with Children and Families* including approaches to talking about death and dying with patients, families and staff.

- **Participants will be invited to review a range of theories and approaches to death and mourning and to consider their use and how they fit with their own personal and professional contexts and those of their clients and their carers.**
- **By the end of the workshop participants can expect to have extended their repertoire of ideas and abilities to approach death, dying and bereavement with children, adults and older people, their families and carers.**



- A skills practice model is used throughout the workshop which includes case material; video; handouts; practice exercises and role play of talking with children and families about death and dying.

**Glenda Fredman** is currently consultant clinical psychologist at University College Hospital London and freelance trainer, consultant and supervisor. 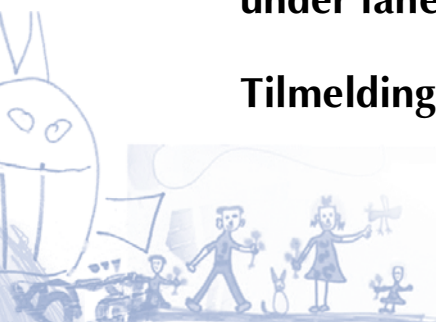
