Lidt om oplægsholderne:

Elsbeth McAdam er børne- og ungdomspsykiater og systemisk terapeut. Hun har tidligere arbejdet i Norwich i England, hvor hun var ansvarlig for adskillige inspirerende projekter i arbejdet med vanskelige børn og unge, som bl.a. har været udsat for seksuelt og fysisk misbrug. Ud over dette har hun arbejdet som supervisor og konsulent i forhold til forskellige former for arbejde omkring børn og familier i Skandinavien. Hun har lavet konsultativt arbejde til større organisationer i både den private og offentlige sektor og har især interesse i "Community Change Projects". Elspeth er nu privatpraktiserende i London.

Jim Wilson har en collaborativ systemisk tilgang til sit kliniske arbejde, og har tidligere i BØPS holdt et meget inspirerende kursus i børnefokuseret praksis. I introduktionen til hans bog Child-Focused Practice, Karnac London 2003 citerer han Oscar Wilde "There is only one thing in the world worse than being talked about and that is not being talked about", dette citat er karakteristisk for hans terapeutiske tilgang.
